PROPER VACUUMING

SAFETY INSTRUCTION CARD OCTOBER



YOUR POSTURE

Keep your elbows close to your body, your wrists not bent and your back straight.



- ✓ Vacuuming carpets? Then you often have to apply extra pressure. In that case, hold the handle of the vacuum cleaner with both hands.
- ✓ Vacuuming laminate and parquet? Hold the handle with one hand. Use the other hand to hold the hose of the vacuum cleaner behind your back.
- Vacuuming under low furniture or beds? Put one knee on the ground and place one hand on that knee.



FIRMLY ON BOTH FEET

Vacuum just in front of you. This way you avoid falling or bumping against furniture, mirrors, decoration,...



- Always use an electrical outlet in the room where you vacuum.
 This way, the cable will never get in the way.
- Adjust your working pace. **Do not make sudden movements.**

WARMLY RECOMMENDED

Never vacuum up flammable or hot materials.

CLIMBING STAIRS

- Proceed very carefully. Ideal is a second vacuum cleaner for the upper floor.
- Vacuuming the stairs? Use a petty thief or hand vacuum cleaner.



DONE VACUUMING?

Clean up the vacuum cleaner immediately. Unplug it - from the wall outlet, not with the cord. Immediately put the vacuum cleaner out of the way.
